

What are Downloadable eBooks?

Downloadable eBooks can be downloaded to a computer or portable reader and accessed at your leisure, whether you are connected to the internet or not. We have over **3000 titles** in our collection. Most are instructional, but we also have several fiction and romance titles.

What Do I Need To Do?

1. **Own a compatible eBook reader.**
Our downloadable eBooks are in PDF format and are optimized to work with **Sony Digital Readers** (PRS-300, 505, 600, 700 and 900). They may also work on other devices that support PDF files.
2. **Download & install Adobe Digital Editions** on your PC/laptop at www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions.
As part of the download, you will be asked to set up a user ID with Adobe. You only have to download the software once and it's free.
3. **Set up an account with NetLibrary**, our eBook provider. (see back panel)

How Long Can I Have a Title?

Most of our titles are checked out for one week. Fiction and romance eBooks are available for two weeks. After the check-out period ends, the eBook will 'expire.' If you try to access an eBook after it expires, you'll see a message advising you that you are not authorized to view the title. eBooks must be removed manually from the computer and portable device. Simply click on the title and press the delete button on the keyboard.

Create a NetLibrary Account

Before you can download an eBook, you will need an account with NetLibrary.

Visit our website:

www.whitbylibrary.on.ca

- Click eBooks (under Quick Links on the right-hand side of the page).
- Enter your library card number
- Click on NetLibrary eBooks.
- Click **“create a free account”**.(upper right corner)
- Fill in **all fields**
- Click **“create account”**

That's all!

You can now download eBooks.

You can log directly into your account and access eBooks by logging into www.netlibrary.com from any computer.

You can access our collection in two ways:

List of Available Titles

Visit our website at:

www.whitbylibrary.on.ca

- Click **eBooks** in *Quick Links*.
- Enter your library card number.
- Click **NetLibrary eBooks**.
- Click **Advanced Search**.
- Check the **Downloadable eBooks** box.
- Type in a search term.

Or

- Click the **Downloadable eBooks** box and search for a complete list of Downloadable titles.

Catalogue

Visit our website at:

www.whitbylibrary.on.ca

- Click **catalogue**.
- Under *Subject main words*, type “**downloadable electronic books.**”
- Click on the **title** of the eBook you want.
- Click the **link in the catalogue record**.
- Enter your **library card number**.
- Click the **link provided** in NetLibrary.

Download eBooks

If you already have a NetLibrary account:

- click “log in” in the upper left corner
- type in your user name and password

*If you don't have an account, see **Create a NetLibrary Account***

Note – Before downloading library titles, you will need to understand your reader and how it works. All associated software should already be installed on your computer. Refer to the instruction manual included with your reader.

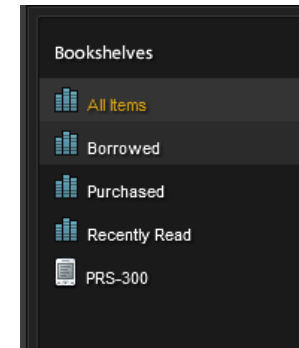
- Find a title you are interested in on the NetLibrary site.
- Click **show details** below the book description.
- Click on **check out & download this eBook**.

Note: If this option is unavailable, it cannot be downloaded, only read online

- Log in to your NetLibrary account.
- Click **download this eContent**.
- Click **open** when asked to open or save a URLLink.acsm file.
- **Adobe Digital Editions** will request that you log in with your Adobe ID. Once logged in, the eBook will download and appear in Digital Editions.

Add to portable eReader

- Hook up the eReader to your computer using the USB cable. The reader will appear in the list on the left-hand side of the Reader Library window.



- Click and drag the title from the list to the eReader icon. This uploads the title to the reader.
